

The Motor Vehicle Sales Authority of British Columbia Call for Nominations – Board of Directors The Customer Compensation Fund

The Provincial Government has delegated the Motor Vehicle Sales Authority of BC (formerly the Motor Dealer Council of BC.) to be responsible for the administration of the Motor Dealer Act. In this capacity the VSA supervises the BC Motor Dealer Customer Compensation Fund.

Where warranted, the Fund compensates consumers who have suffered an eligible financial loss as a result of the purchase, lease or consignment sale of a motor vehicle through a licensed BC motor dealer. Claims against the fund are adjudicated by a Board of Directors (Trustees) who represent both the motor dealer industry and the public at large.

As the terms of appointment of several current members of the board will expire on April 1st, 2009, the Motor Vehicle Sales Authority is inviting applications from interested persons from within the motor dealer industry and from the public-at-large for appointment to its Board of Directors.

All applicants must undergo a criminal background check, and should be able to attest to broad experienced in either the motor dealer industry or in the area of community service and consumer protection. Successful applicants must have a demonstrable experience in board governance.
