As mentioned in our previous bulletin, recent amendments to the *Motor Dealer Act* were made to allow dealers to conduct sales electronically. As more dealers are turning towards online sales models, <u>here are some key</u> considerations for you to know.

Fraud and ID Theft

Be aware of the risks associated with online sales and sales to remote customers. The VSA has been advised by both local police agencies and other Canadian jurisdictions that there has been an increase in the number of transactions involving fraud and ID theft, especially those that are out-of-province. Dealers are encouraged to explore third party identification verification services that are available to businesses to mitigate some of the risk.
