UNDERTAKING

WHEREAS Jason Coburn ("Coburn") salesperson license #106135, (the "Salesperson") is a "salesperson" as defined under the *Motor Dealer Act* R.S.B.C. 1996 c. 316 (the "Act").

AND WHEREAS the Motor Dealer Council of British Columbia dba the Motor Vehicle Sales Authority of British Columbia is the "authority" as defined in the Act (the "Authority") and is responsible for the licensing of "salespersons" under the *Salesperson Licensing Regulation* B.C. Reg. 241/2004 (the "SL Regulation").

AND WHEREAS the "Registrar of Motor Dealers", as defined under the Act, (the "Registrar") is responsible for the administration and enforcement of the Act, its regulations and prescribed provisions of the *Business Practices and Consumer Protection Act* S.B.C. 2004 c. 2 and is an authorized representative of the Authority.

AND WHEREAS the Authority has initiated an investigation involving the Salesperson's conduct in accordance with sections 6 and 7 of the SL Regulation.

AND WHEREAS the Salesperson acknowledges that: On the 4th and 5th day of April, 2012 Jason Coburn attempted to sell a motor vehicle to a consumer while not properly licensed to do so.

AND WHEREAS the Salesperson acknowledges that: On the 4th and 5th day of April 2012 Jason Coburn misrepresented the condition of a vehicle offered by him for sale.

AND WHEREAS the Salesperson acknowledges that: On the 5th day of April 2012 Jason Coburn offered for a sale a motor vehicle that was not in his possession for sale and the offer for sale took place other than at the dealership who rightfully had possession of the vehicle being offered for sale.

AND WHEREAS the Salesperson wishes to resolve these issues voluntarily, without a hearing, by entering into this Undertaking.

THE SALESPERSON HEREBY UNDERTAKES AND AGREES TO:


RECEIVED

- 1) Pay \$100 to the Motor Vehicle Sales Authority towards its investigation and hearing costs by the 15th day of June 2012.
- 2) Pay the Provincial Ticket issued to him and provide proof of payment by the 15th of June 2012.
- 3) Refrain from selling "Motor Vehicles" other than at the dealership.
- 4) Take steps to ensure that all "Motor Vehicles" he is selling meet the Motor Vehicle Act requirements.

THE SALESPERSON ACKNOWLEDGES THAT:

- 1) This Undertaking is being entered into by the Salesperson voluntarily.
- 2) The Salesperson has had an opportunity to obtain legal advice as to the terms of this Undertaking.
- 3) The Authority will make it a condition of the Salesperson's licence to abide by and carry out the terms of this Undertaking.
- 4) The Authority will take steps to monitor and enforce this Undertaking. Enforcement can include, but is not limited to, court action to obtain a compliance order, or the suspension or cancelation of the Salesperson's licence.
- 5) The Authority will review this undertaking with in a six month period.
